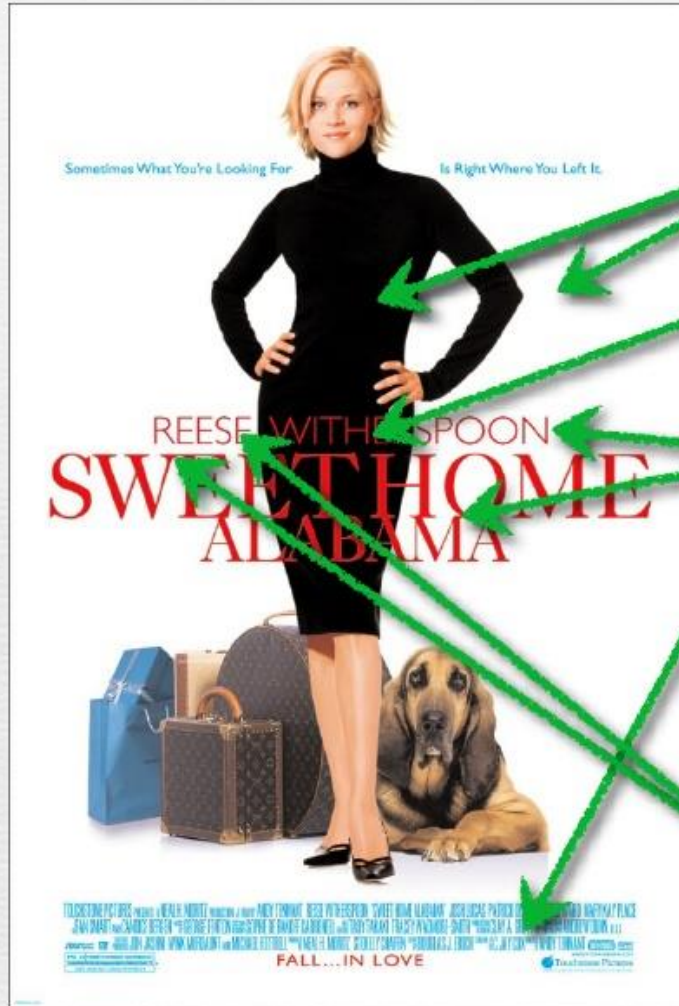
# Small Group Peer Review Practice

Black vs. White

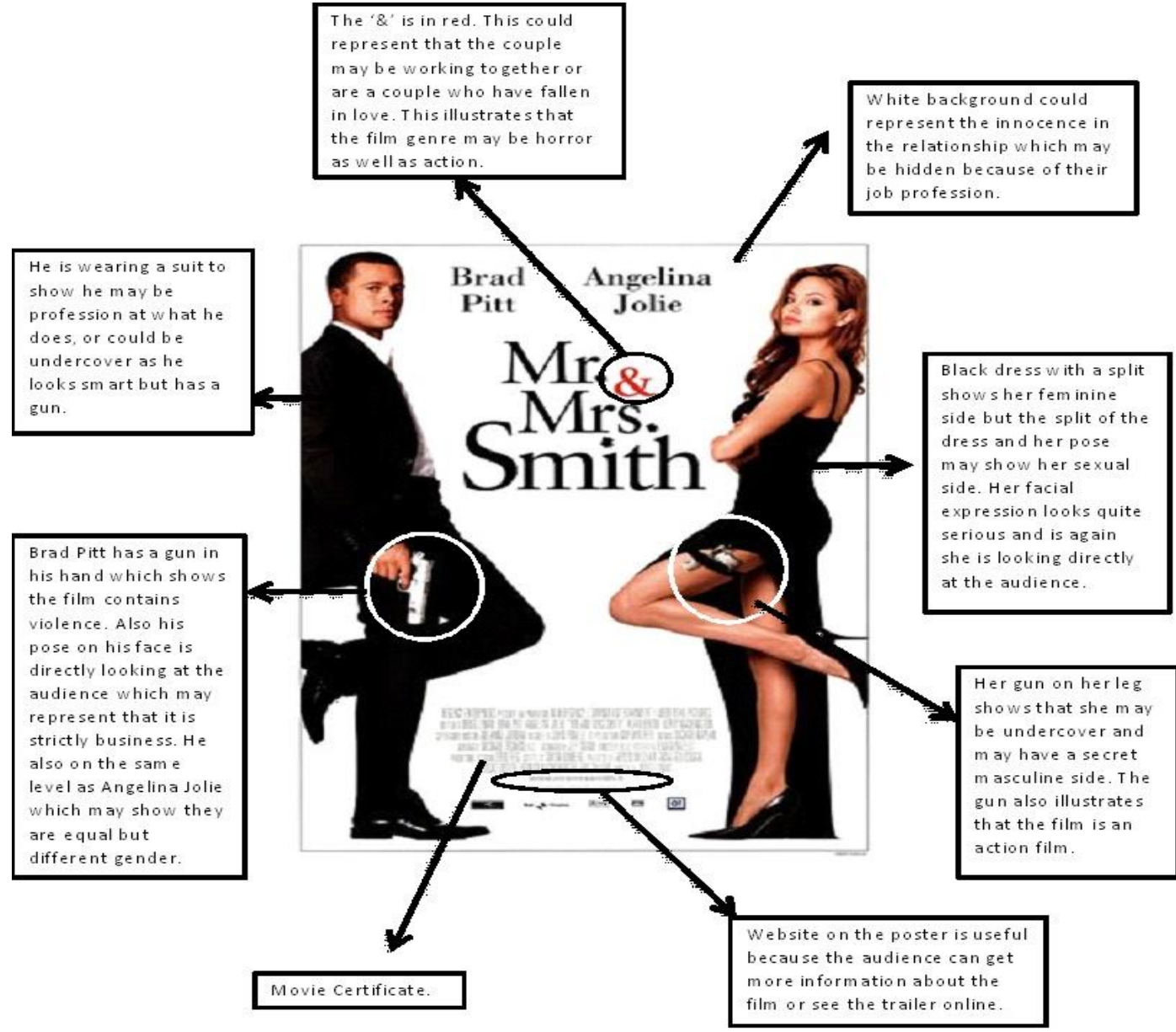
Red vs. Black vs. White

**Alternative to Compiz-Annotate for Kubuntu**

I'm looking for a way to freehand draw on my desktop so I can take screenshots like the one used in this answer. I have the screenshot tool already set up but I don't need the Annotate functionality without installing Compiz.

I'd like to avoid the overhead of a standalone application like Shutter or Inkscape - unless there's a very streamlined workflow for quickly:

1. Annotating the screen (could be across 1 or more running applications)
2. Take a screenshot of the area
3. Upload the image to public hosting (imgur)

Speed is very important - I don't want to wait for a program like Shutter to launch, edit, draw, upload, close. I'd rather just draw, select the area and have the url copied to my clipboard automatically.

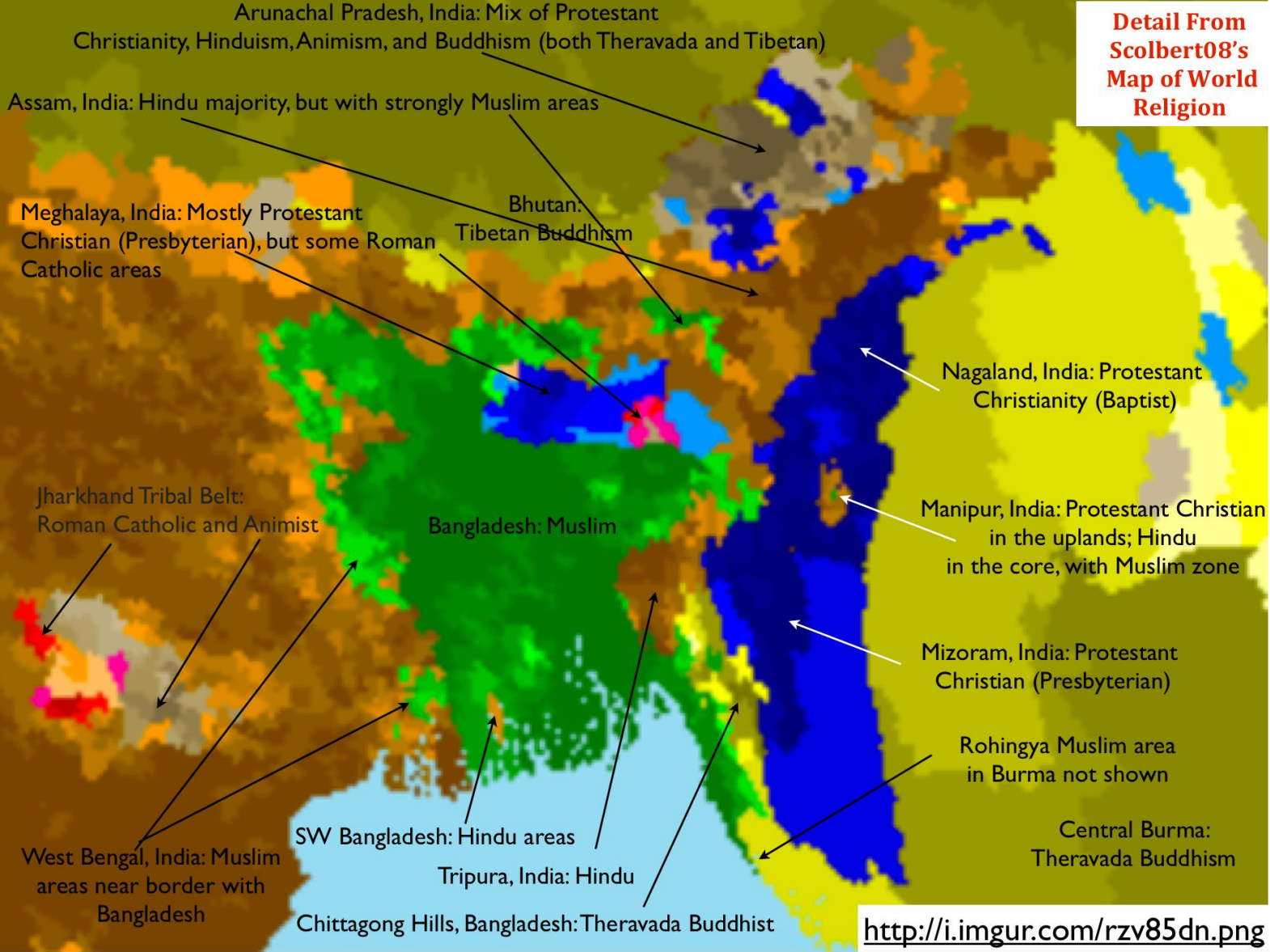
